SWEATER*Raglan sweater w/stripes*

(2) 4 (6) 8 (10) 12 yrs

Measurements:Chest width: (66) 70 (74) 78 (82) 86
cmLength: approx (35) 38 (42) 46 (50)
52 cmSleeve length: (26) 30 (33) 36 (39) 42
cm, or suitable lengthAll measurements are for the finished garment
= personal body measurements + movement
allowance. The measurements are all according
to given tension.**Yarn:**BABYULL LANETT (100 % merino
wool, 50 g = 175 m)**Alternative yarn**MINI ALPAKKA, MANDARIN PETIT,
TYNN MERINOULL, ALPAKKA
SILKE, TYNN ALPAKKA ULL, SISUNote: If alternative yarn is chosen be sure to
check the yardage on label. The image of
garment might change by using alternative yarn**Yarn required:**

Mustard #2335: (3) 3 (4) 4 (5) 6 balls

Natural #1012: (1) 1 (1) 2 (2) 2 balls

Suggested knitting needles:Circular and double pointed 2.5 mm
and 3 mmNeedle sizes are only suggestions. If your
knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker
needles, for looser tension use thinner needle**Tension:**

27 sts St-st with 3 mm ndls = 10 cm

Stripe pattern:Work alternately: 3 rnds mustard, 1
rnd natural.**Back and front:**With mustard and 2.5 mm circular ndl
cast on (196) 206 (220) 232 (244) 256
sts. Join and work 2 cm ribbing k1, p1
in rnds.

Change to 3 mm circular ndl, work

St-st in rnds, **while** dec evenly spaced
(18) 18 (20) 22 (22) 24 sts on first rnd
= (178) 188 (200) 210 (222) 232 sts.Insert marker at sides with (89) 94
(100) 105 (111) 116 sts for each part.Cont St-st and **stripe pattern** until
garment meas approx (22) 24 (27) 30
(33) 34 cm.Cast off 8 sts at each side for
armholes (= 4 sts at each side of
markers).

Put garment aside and work sleeves.

Sleeves:With mustard and 2.5 mm double
pointed ndls cast on (44) 46 (48) 50
(52) 54 sts. Join and work 2 cm
ribbing k1, p1 in rnds.Change to 3 mm double pointed ndls,
and insert marker around first and last
st of rnd.Cont St-st and **stripe pattern**, and
when sleeve meas 6 cm, inc 1 st at
each side of marker.Rep inc approx every 2½ cm until (60)
64 (68) 72 (76) 80 sts on rnd.Cont until sleeve meas (26) 30 (33)
36 (39) 42 cm, or suitable length. End
with the same pattern rnd as
back/front.

Cast off 8 middle underarm sts (=

marked sts + 3 sts at each side).
Put aside and work other sleeve in the
same manner.**Raglan:**Transfer sleeve sts to the circular 3
mm garment ndl, placing one sleeve
above each armhole cast-off = (266)
284 (304) 322 (342) 360 sts.

Insert marker at each junction.

Beg by junction at right side on the
back.Cont St-st and **stripe pattern** and dec
for raglan at each marker as follows:
k2tog after each marker, and sl 1, k1,
pssso before each marker = 8 sts dec.Rep dec on alt rnds a total of (15) 17
(20) 22 (24) 26 times = (146) 148
(144) 146 (150) 152 sts.Transfer the (17) 18 (18) 19 (21) 22
middle front sts to spare ndl, cont to
end of rnd. Cut yarn and beg again at
neck.Cont St-st and **stripe pattern** back
and forth.Cast off 3 sts at beg of every row at
each side, **at the same time** cont dec
for raglan when possible 4 times
more, and a total of (19) 21 (24) 26
(28) 30 times over sts for the back.**NOTE:** Dec for raglan on RS rows.

Leave rem sts on ndl for neckband.

Finishing:

Sew underarm openings.

Neckband:Transfer neck sts to small 2.5 mm
circular ndl, and with mustard knit up
1 st every st/row, but miss every 4th
st/row at neck edge to approx (108)
112 (116) 120 (124) 128 sts.Work approx 6 cm ribbing k1, p1 in
rnds.

Cast off rib-wise.

Fold neckband to WS and sew with
hidden sts.
