SAMUEL SWEATER

Sweater w/round yoke

Instruction: Anita Brathetland

Sizes:

(2) 4 (6) 8 (10) 12 yrs

Measurements:

Chest width: (65) 70 (73) 78 (80) 85 cm

Length: approx (36) 40 (44) 48 (50) 52 cm

Sleeve length: (24) 28 (31) 34 (37) 40 cm, or suitable length

All measurements are for the finished garment = personal body measurements + movement allowance. The measurements are all according to given tension.

Yarn:

KOS (62 % baby alpaca, 9 % wool, 29 % nylon, 50 g = 150 m)

Yarn required:

Lt.grey melange #1021: (3) 3 (4) 4 (5) 6 balls

Petrol melange #6870: 1 ball all sizes

Lt.tawny #2533: 1 ball all sizes

Taupe #4342: 1 ball all sizes

Suggested knitting needles:

Circular and double pointed 5 mm and 5.5 mm

Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle.

Tension:

16 sts St-st with 5.5 mm ndls = 10 cm

Back and front:

With lt.grey melange and 5 mm circular ndl cast on (104) 112 (116) 124 (128) 136 sts. Join and work (3) 3 (3) 4 (4) 4 cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds.

Change to 5.5 mm circular ndl
Insert marker at sides with (52) 56 (58) 62 (64) 68 sts for each part.

Cont St-st until garment meas (21) 25 (28) 32 (33) 34 cm.

Cast off 8 sts at each side for armholes (= 4 sts at each side of markers).

Put garment aside and work sleeves.

Sleeves:

With lt.grey melange and 5 mm double pointed ndls cast on (24) 26 (28) 30 (30) 32 sts. Join and work (3) 3 (3) 4 (4) 4 cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds. Change to 5.5 mm double pointed ndls. Insert marker around first and last st of rnd

Cont St-st and when sleeve meas 6 cm inc 1 st at each side of marker.

Rep inc approx every 3½ cm until (36) 40 (42) 46 (48) 52 sts.

Cont until sleeve meas (24) 28 (31) 34 (37) 40 cm, or suitable length.

Cast off 8 middle underarm sts (= marked sts + 3 sts at each side).

Put aside and work other sleeve the same.

Round yoke:

Transfer sleeve sts to the circular 5.5 mm garment ndl, placing one sleeve above each armhole cast-off = (144) 160 (168) 184 (192) 208 sts.

Cont (2) 2 (4) 4 (7) 9 rnds St-st

Work **diagram** and dec as shown in diagram = (62) 64 (66) 68 (70) 72 sts.

Leave rem sts on ndl for neck.

Finishing:

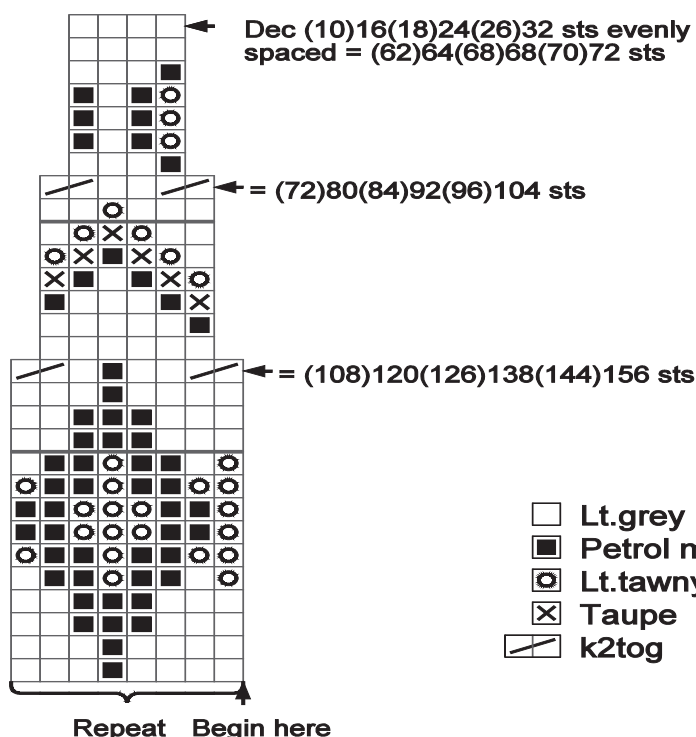
Sew underarm openings.

Neckband:

Change to small 5 mm circular ndl and work 6 cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds.

Cast off rib-wise.

Fold neckband to WS and sew loosely with hidden sts.
