#GRONLANDGENSER / NO 5 / INSTRUCTION: UNN SØILAND
***MEDIUM

SIZE

(2) 4 (6) 8 (10) 12 yrs

MEASUREMENTS

Chest width: (64) 69 (76) 80 (84) 89 cm

Length: (36) 40 (44) 48 (50) 53 cm

Sleeve length: (24) 28 (31) 35 (38) 42 cm, or suitable length

All measurements are for the finished garment = personal body measurements + movement allowance. The measurements are all according to given tension.

THE GARMENT

Work garment from neck down.

To create and shape a deeper front neckline, work turning rows with GSR.

Work St-st with pattern according to diagram and inc for round yoke.

YARN

SISU (80 % wool, 20 % nylon, 50 g = 175 m)

ALTERNATIVE YARN

MINI ALPAKKA, MANDARIN PETIT, ALPAKKA SILKE, TYNN MERINOULL, BABYULL LANETT

NOTE: If alternative yarn is chosen be sure to check the yardage on label. The image of garment might change by using alternative yarn.

YARN REQUIRED

Moonstone #2122/Lt.green #9041: (2) 3 (3) 3 (4) 5 balls

Lt.moss green #9844/Dk.green #8063: (1) 1 (1) 2 (2) 2 balls

Blue hydrangea #6032/Dill #8552: 1 ball each size

Old rose #4513/Blue hydrangea #6032: 1 ball each size

Rose tree #4245/Dk.blue #6062: 1 ball each size

SUGGESTED KNITTING NEEDLES

Circular and double pointed 2.5 mm and 3 mm

Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle

TENSION

27 sts St-st with 3 mm ndls = 10 cm

INC 1

Pick up yarn between 2 sts and k tbl the new stitch

INC RIGHT

From the back insert left ndl under yarn between 2 sts and k the new stitch.

INC LEFT

From front insert left ndl under yarn between 2 sts and k tbl the new stitch.

GSR = GERMAN SHORT ROWS

After each turning always sl first st p-wise with yarn in front of work, lead yarn over right ndl and pull yarn firmly at the back until 2 loops on ndl. The 2 loops count as 1 st. When working rows/rnds with loops work loops tog to 1 st.

YOKE

With lt.moss green and 2.5 mm circular ndl cast on (100) 104 (108) 112 (114) 116 sts. Join and work (6) 6 (7) 7 (8) 8 cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds for double neckband.

Change to 3 mm circular ndl, k 1 rnd while inc (8) 10 (12) 14 (18) 22 sts evenly spaced = (108) 114 (120) 126 (132) 138 sts.


Insert marker at beg of rnd = middle back, and one at middle front with (54) 57 (60) 63 (66) 69 sts between markers.

Work [diagram A](#).

Note: See arrow in diagram and with blue hydrangea/dill work turning rows with GSR (see explanation) as follows:

Knit until 27 sts rem before middle front marker, turn, purl until 27 sts rem before middle front marker on other side, turn.

Turn in the same manner, but work 2,4,6 sts pass previous turning, until a total of 4 times on each side.



- ROSE TREE/DK.BLUE
- OLD ROSE/BLUE HYDRANGEA
- LT.MOSS GREEN/DK.GREEN
- BLUE HYDRANGEA/DILL
- MOONSTONE/LT.GREEN
- INC 1: PICK UP YARN BETWEEN 2 STS AND K TBL THE NEW STITCH

Work diagram B and C = (240) 260 (280) 300 (320) 340 sts.

Cont with moonstone/lt.green.

Size (6) 8 (10) 12 yrs

Cont St-st and insert markers for raglan inc as follows: Work (41) 44 (46) 49 sts (= ½ back), work and insert marker around next st, work (56) 60 (66) 70 sts (= sleeve), work and insert marker around next st, work (82) 88 (92) 98 sts (= front), work and insert marker around next st, work (56) 60 (66) 70 sts (= sleeve), work and insert marker around next st. Rnd beg here over sts for the back = (82) 88 (92) 98 sts.

Cont St-st, inc right before each marker and inc left after each marker = 8 sts inc.

Rep inc on alt rnds (1) 2 (2) 3 times more = (296) 324 (344) 372 sts.

All sizes:

Work (1) 1 (1) 1 (4) 6 rnds St-st, at the same time adjust number of sts to (246) 270 (300) 324 (348) 372 on first rnd.

Divide work for sleeves back and front as follows:

Work (37) 41 (45) 48 (51) 54 sts (= ½ back), transfer (48) 54 (60) 66 (72) 78 sts to spare ndl for sleeve, cast on 12 new sts, work (75) 81 (90) 96 (102) 108 sts (= front), transfer (48) 54 (60) 66 (72) 78 sts to spare ndl for sleeve, cast on 12 new sts, work (75) 81 (90) 96 (102) 108 sts = the full back.

BACK AND FRONT

= (174) 186 (204) 216 (228) 240 sts.

Insert marker in middle of underarm sts at on side = beg of rnd.

Cont with moonstone/lt.green.

Work St-st in rnds until garment meas approx (28) 32 (35) 39 (40) 43 cm, meas straight down from after ribbing, with garment placed flat, or (8) 8 (9) 9 (10) 10 cm before suitable length.

Work diagram D.

Cont with lt.moss green/dk.green and 2.5 mm circular ndl and work (4) 4 (5) 5 (6) 6 cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds. Cast off suitable loose rib-wise.

SLEEVES

Transfer sleeve sts to 3 mm double pointed ndls, and with moonstone/lt.green knit up 1 st in each of the new underarm sts = (60) 66 (72) 78 (84) 90 sts.

Insert marker at middle of underarm sts = beg of rnd.

Tips: Pick up yarn between sleeve sts and on each side of new underarm sts, and on first rnd knit this st tog with next st to avoid hole in garment.

Work 2 cm St-st and dec 2 sts on next rnd as follows:

Sl 1 k-wise, k1, pssso, work until 2 sts rem on rnd, and k2tog.

Rep dec every 2 cm until (48) 48 (54) 54 (60) 60 sts rem.

Cont St-st until sleeve meas (14) 18 (20) 24 (26) 30 cm, or (10) 10 (11) 11 (12) 12 cm before suitable length.

Work diagram D.

Cont with lt.moss green/dk green, k 1 rnd while dec (6) 4 (8) 6 (10) 8 sts evenly spaced = (42) 44 (46) 48 (50) 52 sts.

Change to 2.5 mm double pointed ndls and work (4) 4 (5) 5 (6) 6 cm ribbing k1, p1.

Cast off suitable loose rib-wise.

Work other sleeve in the same manner.

FINISHING

Fold neckband to WS and sew loosely with hidden sts.

Fasten all yarn ends.
