

STRIPE SWEATER W/TEDDY

#STRIPEGENSER / NO 6 / INSTRUCTION: ANITA B. BENZENBERG KNITTING SKILL LEVEL ** EASY

SIZE

(2) 4 (6) 8 (10) 12 yrs

MEASUREMENTS

Chest width: (68) 73 (77) 81 (86) 89 cm

Length: (34) 38 (42) 46 (48) 50 cm, or suitable length Sleeve length: (24) 28 (31) 34 (37) 40 cm, or suitable length

All measurements are for the finished garment = personal body measurements + movement allowance. The measurements are all according to given tension.

THE SWEATER

Work sweater from neck down with inc for raglan. Work turning rows with GSR to create and shape front neckline. Divide work for sleeves, back and front. Cont to work back and front in rnds. Work sleeves. At finishing embroider teddy motif with knit sts on front.

YARN

SISU (80 % wool, 20 % nylon, 50 g = 175 m)

ALTERNATIVE YARN

MINI ALPAKKA, MANDARIN PETIT, ALPAKKA SILKE, TYNN MERINOULL, BABYULL LANETT

NOTE: If alternative yarn is chosen be sure to check the yardage on label. The image of garment might change by using alternative yarn.

YARN REQUIRED

Dk.curry #2336/Moss green #9573: (2) 3 (3) 4 (4) 5 balls

Lt.limestone #2319/Lt.limestone #2319: (2) 2 (2) 3 (3) 4 balls

For embroidery:

Acorn #3161: 1 ball

Lt.beige melange #2650: 1 ball

Black #1099: 1 ball

SUGGESTED KNITTING NEEDLES

Circular and double pointed 2.5 mm and 3 mm

Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle

TENSION

27 sts St-st with 3 mm ndls = 10 cm

GSR = GERMAN SHORT ROWS

After each turning always sl first st p-wise with yarn in front of work, lead yarn over right ndl and pull yarn firmly at the back until 2 loops on ndl. The 2 loops count as 1 st. When working rows/rnds with loops work loops tog to 1 st.

INC RIGHT

From the back insert left ndl under yarn between 2 sts and k the new stitch.

INC LEFT

From front insert left ndl under yarn between 2 sts and k tbl the new stitch.

BEG AT NECK

With dk.curry/moss green and 2.5 mm circular ndl cast on (100) 104 (108) 112 (116) 120 sts. Join and work (6) 6 (6) 7 (7) 7 cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds.

Change to 3 mm circular ndl and, work 1 rnd ribbing and insert markers for raglan inc as follows:

Work and insert marker around first st, work (13) 13 (13) 13 (13) 15 sts (= sleeve), work and insert marker around next st, work (35) 37 (39) 41 (43) 43 sts (= the back), work and insert marker around next st, work (13) 13 (13) 13 (13) 15 sts (= sleeve), work and insert marker around next st, work (35) 37 (39) 41 (43) 43 sts (= front).

Rnd beg at marker between front and the back.

Work turning rows with <u>GSR</u> and inc for raglan by each marker as follows:

Inc right, work marked st, inc left, work St-st until next marked st, rep from *-* at all 4 marked sts and work until 3 sts in on front, turn and purl back until 4 sts in on front at other side = 8 sts inc.

Info: Due to raglan inc work 4 sts in on front to establish turning at same point as other side.

Change to lt.limestone, work <u>diagram</u>, and cont back and forth in the same manner, but work 3,3,2,2,1 sts more for each turning until a total of 6 times on each side = (148) 152 (156) 160 (164) 168 sts.

Cut yarn and move beg of rnd to marked st between right sleeve and the back.

Work <u>diagram</u> and cont inc for raglan on alt rnds until a total of (23) 25 (27) 28 (30) 32 times = (284) 304 (324) 336 (356) 376 sts.

Divide work for sleeves, back and front as follows: Beg with marked st and work (83) 89 (95) 99 (105) 109 sts (= the back), transfer the next (59) 63 (67) 69 (73) 79 sts to spare ndl for sleeve and cast on (9) 9 (9) 11 (11) 11 new underarm sts, work (83) 89 (95) 99 (105) 109 sts (= front), transfer the next (59) 63 (67) 69 (73) 79 sts to spare ndl for sleeve and cast on (9) 9 (9) 11 (11) 11 new underarm sts.

BACK AND FRONT

= (184) 196 (208) 220 (232) 240 sts.

Insert marker around the middle underarm stitch of one sleeve = beg of rnd.

Cont with <u>diagram</u> until garment meas approx (30) 34 (38) 42 (44) 46 cm, or until 4 cm before suitable length, end with 2 rnds dk.curry/moss green.

Tips: Place garment flat with front neck facing, and meas from highest point on shoulder and straight down.

Change to $2.5 \, \text{mm}$ circular ndl and work $4 \, \text{cm}$ ribbing k1, p1 in rnds.

Cast off rib-wise, or work Italian cast-off.

SLEEVES

Transfer sts from spare ndl to 3 mm double pointed ndls, and knit up 1 st in each of the new middle underarm sts = (68) 72 (76) 80 (84) 90 sts.

Tips: Pick up yarn between sleeve sts and at each side of the new underarm sts, and on first rnd knit the new st tog with next st to avoid hole in the work.

Insert marker around middle underarm st.

Cont diagram and work until sleeve meas 2 cm.

Dec 1 st at each side of marked st as follows:

Work marked st, sl 1 k-wise, k1, psso, work until 2 sts rem before marked st, k2tog.

Repeat dec approx every 1% cm until (44) 46 (48) 50 (52) 54 sts rem.

Cont until sleeve meas approx (20) 24 (27) 30 (33) 36 cm, or until 4 cm before suitable length.

End with 2 rnds dk.curry/moss green, and dec 4 sts evenly spaced on last rnd = (40) 42 (44) 46 (48) 50 sts. Change to 2.5 mm double pointed ndls and work 4 cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds.

Cast off rib-wise or work Italian cast off.

Work other sleeve in the same manner.

FINISHING

Fold neckband to WS and sew loosely with hidden sts. Embroider teddy motif with knit sts at middle front. Beg 9 stripes from ribbing.
