Sweater w/hood in structural pattern Instruction: Liv Stangeland

Sizes:

(2) 4 (6) 8 (10) 12 yrs

Measurements:

Chest width: (65) 68 (71) 76 (80) 86 cm Length: approx (36) 40 (44) 48 (50) 52 cm Sleeve length: (24) 27 (30) 33 (36) 40 cm, or suitable length

All measurements are for the finished garment = personal body measurements + movement allowance. The measurements are all according to given tension.

Yarn:

SISU (80 % wool, 20 % nylon, 50 g = 175 m)

Alternative yarn:

MINI ALPAKKA, MANDARIN PETIT, ALPAKKA SILKE, TYNN MERINOULL, BABYULL LANETT

NOTE: If alternative yarn is chosen be sure to check the yardage on label. The image of garment might change by using alternative yarn.

Yarn required:

Petrol #6553: (5) 6 (6) 7 (7) 8 balls

Suggested knitting needles:

Circular and double pointed 2.5 mm and 3 mm

Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle.

Tension:

27 sts pattern with 3 mm ndls = 10 cm

GSR = German Short Rows:

After each turning always sl first st with yarn in front of work (as working a p st), lead yarn over right ndl, pull yarn firmly at the back until 2 loops on ndl. The 2 loops count as 1 stitch. When working rows/rnds with loops, work loops tog to 1 st.

Pattern worked in rnds:

Pattern rnd 1: Work *k1, p1*, rep from** in the rnd.

Pattern rnd 2: k all sts. Rep pattern rnd 1-2.

Inc 1 st:

Pick up yarn between 2 sts and k tbl this new st.

Back and front:

With 3 mm circular ndl cast on (176) 184 (192) 204 (216) 232 sts. Join and and work pattern in rnds.

Insert marker around 1 k st at each side with (87) 91 (95) 101 (107) 115 sts between markers.

Work until garment meas (24) 27 (30) 33 (34) 35 cm.

Cast off 7 sts at each side for armholes (= marked st + 3 sts at each side), end with pattern rnd 1.

Put garment aside and work sleeves.

Sleeves:

With 2.5 mm double pointed ndls cast on (44) 48 (48) 52 (52) 54 sts. Join and work (2) 2 (3) 3 (3) 3 cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds. Insert marker around last st on rnd = 1 p stitch

Change to 3 mm double pointed ndls and k 1 rnd.

Cont pattern and when sleeve meas (4) 5 (3) 3 (3) 4 cm inc 1 st at each side of marker.

Rep inc every (1%) 2 (1%) 2 (1%) 2 cm until (64) 68 (76) 80 (88) 90 sts. Cont until sleeve meas (24) 27 (30) 33 (36) 40 cm, or suitable length.

Cast off 7 middle underarm sts (= marked st + 3 sts at each side), end with pattern rnd 1.

Put aside and work other sleeve in the same manner.

Raglan:

Transfer sleeve sts to the circular 3 mm garment ndl, placing one sleeve above each armhole cast-off = (276) 292 (316) 336 (364) 384 sts. Insert marker around 9 sts at each junction, with 6 sts from back/front and 3 sts from sleeve. Work pattern further over marked sts, and these sts are not affected by raglan dec. Rnd beg at right side on the back, and the 6 first sts on the back are part of marked sts and belog together with the last 3 marked sts on the rnd. K 1 rnd.

Cont pattern and dec for raglan as follows: Work 6 marked sts, *sl 1 k-wise, k2tog, psso, work until 3 sts rem before next marker, k2tog, transfer st back to left ndl, pass next st over and transfer st to right ndl, work marked sts*, rep from *-* in the rnd = 16 sts dec.

Rep dec every 4th rnd a total of (9) 10 (11) 12 (13) 14 times = (132) 132 (140) 144 (156) 160 sts, work 3 rnds after last dec, at the same time transfer the (15) 15 (17) 17 (19) 19 middle front sts to spare ndl for neck and cont to end of rnd. Cut yarn and beg again at neck. Cont pattern but p WS rows. Beg from RS, dec for raglan every 4th row as usual (3) 3 (3) 3 (4) 4 times where possible, at the same time cast off 2 sts at beg of every row further. Cast off rem sts.

Finishing:

Neckband:

Beg rnd at middle back. With 2.5 mm circular ndl knit up 1 st every st/row at neck edge, and at the same time join sts from spare ndl until approx (102) 102 (110) 110 (118) 122 sts on rnd.

Number of sts a multiple of 2.

Work 2 cm pattern in the rnd, and make sure pattern matches at middle front. End with pattern rnd 1. Cut yarn and leave sts on ndl for hood.

Pattern worked back and forth:

Pattern row 1: (= RS) k all sts.
Pattern row 2: (= WS): Work k1, *p1, k1*, rep from *-* to end of row.
Repeat pattern row 1- 2.

Hood:

Beg at middle front.

Transfer (102) 102 (110) 110 (118) 122 sts to 3 mm circular ndl, cast off the middle front st and work 2 rows pattern back and forth, and make sure pattern matches. Insert marker around 1 st at middle back. Work extra height for hood with **GSR** as follows:

1 edge st, 4 sts pattern, turn, work back. Work 1 edge st, work until 4 sts pass previous turning, turn, work back. Cont to work and turn in this manner until a total of (6) 6 (6) 6 (7) 7 times. Work all sts and rep from *_* at the other side. Cont back and forth over all sts until hood meas 2 cm at middle back.

Inc 1 st at each side of middle back marker.

Rep inc every 1½ cm a total of (6) 8 (8) 10 (10) 10 times = (113) 117 (125) 129 (137) 141 sts. Work new sts in pattern as they arise.

Cont until hood meas (20) 21 (22) 23 (24) 25 cm at middle back and straight up. Cast off the (11) 11 (13) 13 (15) 15 middle sts and work each side separately.



Work (2) 2 (2½) 2½ (3) 3 cm pattern back and forth over rem (51) 53 (56) 58 (61) 63 sts.

Transfer sts to spare ndl. Work other side in the same manner. Place sides with RS facing and k 1 st from each part tog, **at the same time** cast off. Sew cast off sts at middle back to sides at top of hood.

Edge st: k every row Hood edging:

Beg at middle front.

With 3 mm circular ndl knit up at edge of hood 1 st every st/row, but miss every 4th st/row, to approx (137) 141 (149) 153 (157) 161 sts.

Number of sts a multiple of 2 +1. Work 4 rows ribbing back and forth as follows:

(First row = WS) 1 edge st, k1, *p1, k1*, rep from *-*, end with 1 edge st. From WS k 1 row (= folding row). Change to 2.5 mm circular ndl and work 4 rows St-st inside 1 edge st at each side (= facing).

Cast off.

Fold facing and sew nicely with hidden sts on WS.

With 2 strands of yarn twist cord of suitable length and pass through edging of hood.

Sew underarm openings.





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
