# CABLE SWEATER

Cable sweater for ladies Instruction: Liv Stangeland

#### Sizes:

(S) M (L) XL (XXL)

## Measurements:

Bust: (91) 99 (107) 115 (123) cm Length: approx (54) 56 (58) 61 (64)

CIII

Sleeve length: 47 cm, or suitable length

All measurements are for the finished garment = personal body measurements + movement allowance. The measurements are all according to given tension

#### Yarn:

TOVE (100 % Norwegian wool, 50 g = 160 m)

# Alternative yarn:

TYNN ALPAKKA ULL

Note: If alternative yarn is chosen be sure to check the yardage on label. The image of garment might change by using alternative yarn.

### Yarn required:

Red melange #4236: (7) 7 (8) 9 (10) balls

## Suggested knitting needles:

Circular and double pointed 3 mm Cable ndl

Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle.

#### Tension:

25 sts St-st and 30 sts pattern with 3 mm ndls = 10 cm

## **Back and front:**

With 3 mm circ ndl cast on (236) 256 (276) 296 (316) sts. Beg at front and work 4 cm ribbing in rnds as follows:

(S) and (XXL):

\*p2, k2\*, rep from \*-\* in the rnd. **Size M:** 

K1, \*p2, k2\*, rep from \*-\*, end with k1 **Size (L):** 

\*K2, p2\*, rep from \*-\* in the rnd.

Sizes XL:

P1, \*k2, p2\*, rep from\*-\*, end with p1

## All sizes:

Insert marker at sides with (118) 128 (138) 148 (158) sts for each part. Insert marker at center front between 2 k sts, and one marker around the 54 center front sts. Work pattern over these 54 sts (= 60 masker after 1st rnd), work p over rem sts, **while** dec 4 sts evenly spaced over sts for the back = (238) 258 (278) 298 (318) sts. Cont in this order until work meas (33) 34 (35) 36 (37) cm.

Cast off 10 sts at each side for armholes (= 5 sts at each side of markers).

Put garment aside and work sleeves.

#### Sleeves:

With 3 mm double pointed ndls cast on (48) 52 (52) 56 (56) sts. Join and work 4 cm ribbing k2, p2 in rnds.

Insert marker on first and last st of rnd.

Cont in **p sts** and when sleeve meas 7 cm inc 1 st at each side of marker. Rep inc every (2) 2 (2) 1½ (1½) cm until (84) 88 (92) 98 (102) sts on rnd. Cont until sleeve meas 47 cm, or suitable length.

Cast off 10 center underarm sts (= marked sts + 4 sts at each side). Put aside and work other sleeve the same.

# Raglan:

Transfer sleeve sts to the 3 mm circular garment ndl, placing one sleeve above each armhole cast-off = (366) 394 (422) 454 (482) sts.

Insert marker on 2 sts at each junction = 4 markers, and work St-st on these sts throughout.

Cont in **p sts** and **diagram** and dec for raglan at each marker as follows: Work until 1 st before marker, k2tog,

sl 1, k1, psso = 8 sts dec.

Rep dec on alt rnds a total of (21) 23 (25) 27 (29) times, **while** on last rnd dec 2 sts over the inc sts at center front (as shown in diagram) = (196) 208 (220) 236 (248) sts.

Transfer the (18) 20 (20) 22 (22) center front sts for neck to spare ndl. Cut yarn and beg again at neck.

Cont back and forth with p on RS, k on WS and diagram, while cast off for neck 2 sts at beg of every row, and at the same time cont raglan dec as before when possible (9) 10 (10) 10 (10) times more, to a total of (30) 33 (35) 37 (39) times over sts for the back

**NOTE:** Work raglan dec on RS rows. Leave rem sts on spare ndl for neck.

# Finishing:

Sew underarm openings.

#### Neckband:

Transfer neck sts to 3 mm circ ndl and knit up sts at edge. Work 1 rnd ribbing k2, p2, **while** dec evenly spaced to (116) 120 (120) 124 (124) sts.

Work 6 cm ribbing k2, p2 in rnds. Cast off rib-wise.

Fold neckband to WS and sew loosely.
