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

SWEATER WITH LACE PATTERN

SWEATER W/LACE PATTERN ON SLEEVES / INSTRUCTION: LIV STANGELAND



SIZES (2) 4 (6) 8 (10) 12 yrs

MEASUREMENTS

Chest width: (62) 64 (68) 72 (78) 82 cm Length: (36) 40 (44) 48 (52) 53 cm Sleeve length: (25) 28 (31) 34 (37) 39 cm, or suitable length

All measurements are for the finished garment = personal body measurements + movement allowance. The measurements are all according to given tension.

YARN

TYNN LINE (53 % cotton, 33 % viscose, 14 % linen, 50 g = 220 m)

YARN REQUIRED

Dusty pastel blue #7521: (2) 3 (3) 4 (5) 6 balls

SUGGESTED KNITTING NEEDLES

Circular and double pointed 3 mm Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle

TENSION

27 sts St-st with 3 mm ndls = 10 cm

PATTERN WORKED IN ROUNDS

A multiple of 29. <u>Rnd 1 - 3</u>: p1, k13, p1, k13, p1 <u>Rnd 4</u>: p1, k4tog, *1 yo, k5*, rep *-* 5 times, 1 yo, k4tog tbl, p1, k4tog, *1 yo, k5*, rep *-* 5 times, 1 yo, k4tog tbl, p1. Rep rnd 1 - 4.

BACK AND FRONT

With 3 mm circular ndl cast on (168) 172 (184) 194 (210) 222 sts. Join and p 1 rnd. Cont St-st until work meas (24) 27 (30) 32 (35) 35 cm. Insert marker at sides with (84) 86 (92) 97 (105) 111 sts for each part. Cast off 10 sts at each side (= 5 sts at each side of markers). Put garment aside and work sleeves.

SLEEVES

With 3 mm double pointed ndls cast on (39)

41 (43) 45 (47) 49 sts. Join and p 1 rnd. Work (5) 6 (7) 8 (9) 10 sts St-st, 29 sts <u>pattern</u>, (5) 6 (7) 8 (9) 10 sts St-st.

Insert marker around 2 middle underarm sts. Cont in this order until sleeve meas (4) 5 (1) 1 (1) 1 cm.

Inc 1 st at each side of marker and work new sts in St-st. Rep inc every (1½) 1½ (1½) 1½ (2) 2 cm until (67) 71 (75) 79 (83) 87 sts on ndls. Cont until sleeve meas (25) 28 (31) 34 (37) 39 cm, or suitable length

Cast off 10 middle underarm sts. Work other sleeve in the same manner.

RAGLAN DEC

Transfer sleeve sts to the circular 3 mm garment ndl, placing one sleeve above each armhole

cast-off = (262) 274 (294) 312 (336) 356 sts. Insert marker at each junction. Rnd beg at right side on the back:

<u>1st dec:</u> *p1, k2tog, work St-st until 3 sts before marker, k2tog tbl, p1, k2tog, cont as before until 2 sts before marker, k2tog tbl*, rep from *-* = 8 sts dec.

<u>Rep 1st dec</u> on alt rnds (7) 10 (12) 14 (16) 18 times = (206) 194 (198) 200 (208) 212 sts on ndl.

2nd dec: work *p1, k3tog, cont

St-st until 4 sts before marker, k3tog tbl, p1, k2tog, work as before until 2 sts before marker, k2tog tbl*, rep from *-* = 12 sts dec. <u>Rep 2nd dec</u> on alt rnds a total of (7) 6 (6) 6 (6) 6 times = (122) 122 (126) 128 (136) 140 sts. <u>3rd dec</u>: *k3tog, work St-st until 3 sts before marker, k3tog tbl, work <u>pattern</u>*, rep from *-* = 8 sts dec.

Rep 3rd dec once more = (106) 106 (110) 112 (120) 124 sts on ndl.

Work k 1 rnd, p 1 rnd, k 1 rnd, p 1 rnd. Cast off.

FINISHING

Sew underarm openings.
