TOP

TOP WITH TRIANGLE EYELET PATTERN / INSTRUCTION: LIV STANGELAND

SIZES

(XS-S) M-L (XL-XXL)

MEASUREMENTS

Bust: (108) 120 (130) cm

Length: (48) 50 (52) cm

All measurements are for the finished garment = personal body measurements + movement allowance. The measurements are all according to given tension.

YARN

TYNN LINE (53 % cotton, 33 % viscose, 14 % linen, 50 g = 220 m)

YARN REQUIRED

Dusty pastel blue #7521: (3) 4 (4) balls

SUGGESTED KNITTING NEEDLES

Circular and double pointed 3 mm

Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle

TENSION

27 sts St-st and 25 sts eyelet pattern with 3 mm ndls = 10 cm

EDGE ST: K EVERY ROW

BACK AND FRONT

With 3 mm circular ndl cast on (286) 318 (346) sts. Join and p 2 rounds. Insert marker at sides with (143) 159 (173) sts for each part. Insert marker on each side of the 31 middle sts at back and front. Cont St-st in rnds and with 31 sts diagram at middle front and middle back.

Cont until garment meas (22) 23 (24) cm. Divide garment at sides and work each side separately.

FRONT

= (143) 159 (173) sts.

Cont back and forth in the same order as before with 1 edge st at each side until garment meas approx (40) 42 (44) cm, ending with a full, $\frac{3}{4}$, half or $\frac{1}{4}$ diagram.

NOTE: For $\frac{3}{4}$ and $\frac{1}{4}$ diagram: end with eyelet row over the other triangle as well to finish pattern with 2 small triangles.

Transfer the 31 middle sts to spare ndl for neck, and work each part separately = (56) 64 (71) sts.

Cast off at neck on alt rows 3 sts once for all sizes, 1 st (5) 6 (6) times, at the same time shape and cast off shoulder sts at beg of every row from armhole side 3 sts (10) 3 (0) times, 4 sts (4) 11 (10) times, 5 sts (0) 0 (4) times. Work other side in same manner but in a mirror image.

BACK

= (143) 159 (173) sts.

Cont back and forth in the same order as before with 1 edge st at each side. Shape and cast off shoulder sts in the same manner and at same height as front. When 3 cast-off rem = (75) 77 (83) sts on ndl, transfer the (39) 41 (41) middle sts to spare ndl for neck and work each side separately.

Cont cast off for shoulder and at the same time cast off 3 sts twice at neck on alt rows.

Work other side in the same manner but in a mirror image.

FINISHING

Sew shoulder seams.

With small 3 mm circular ndl knit up 1 st every st/row, but miss every 4th st/row at neck edge, and include sts from spare ndl. P 2 rnds. Cast off.
