BASIC HAT

Solid color hat

Instruction: Anita Brathetland

Sizes:

(0-3) 6-9 mos (1) 2 (4) yrs

Yarn:

BABYULL LANETT (100 % merino wool, 50 g = 175 m)

Alternative yarn:

MINI ALPAKKA, MANDARIN PETIT, TYNN MERINOULL, ALPAKKA SILKE, SISU

Note: If alternative yarn is chosen be sure to check the yardage on label. The image of garment might change by using alternative yarn

Yarn required:

Rusty brown #2755: (1) 1 (1) 2 (2) balls

Suggested knitting needles:

Circular and double pointed 2.5 mm and 3 mm

Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle

Tension:

27 sts St-st with 3 mm ndls = 10 cm

With 2.5 mm circular ndl cast on (96) 100 (104) 108 (112) sts. Join and work (2) 2 (3) 3 (3) cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds.

Change to 3 mm circular ndl.

Cont St-st until work meas approx (13) 14 (15) 16 (17) cm.

Transfer half number of sts to another ndl, fold work with RS facing and from WS k 1 st from each ndl tog and at the same time cast off

Earflap:

With 3 mm double pointed ndls cast on (40) 40 (44) 44 (48) sts. Join and work (2) 2 (3) 3 (3) cm St-st in rnds. Insert marker at each side with (20) 20 (22) 22 (24) sts for each part. Dec as follows on next rnd: sl 1, k1, psso after each each marker, and k2tog before each marker. Rep dec on alt rnds until 4 sts rem. Work cord over rem sts as follows: K 1 row, slide sts back to other side of ndl, hold yarn firmly and k the 4 sts.

Cont in this manner and knit sts from the same side without turning.

Cont until cord meas approx (20) 20 (22) 24 (26) cm.

Cut yarn, pull through sts, gather and fasten well.

Work other earflap in the same manner.

Finishing:

Sew earflaps to inside of hat on rnd between ribbing and St-st part, and with approx (6) 7 (7) 8 (8) cm space between at middle back.

Make 2 pompoms, with approx \emptyset 3½ cm and fasten one to each corner of hat (see photo).

BASIC CARDIGAN

Raglan cardigan Instruction: Anita Brathetland

Sizes:

(0-3) 6 (9) 12 mos (2) 4 yrs

Measurements:

Chest width: (48) 52 (56) 60 (64) 68

Length: approx (24) 26 (28) 31 (36) 40 cm

Sleeve length: (13) 15 (18) 21 (23) 26 cm, or suitable length

All measurements are for the finished garment = personal body measurements + movement allowance. The measurements are all according to given tension.

Yarn:

BABYULL LANETT (100 % merino wool, 50 g = 175 m)

Alternative yarn:

MINI ALPAKKA, MANDARIN PETIT, TYNN MERINOULL, ALPAKKA SILKE, SISU

Note: If alternative yarn is chosen be sure to check the yardage on label. The image of garment might change by using alternative yarn

Yarn required:

Lt.grey melange #1022: (2) 2 (3) 3 (4) 4 balls

Notions:

(5) 5 (5) 6 (6) 6 buttons

Suggested knitting needles:

Circular and double pointed 2.5 mm and 3 mm

Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle

Tension:

27 sts St-st with 3 mm ndls = 10 cm

Edge: k every row

Back and front:

With 2.5 mm circular ndl cast on (127) 137 (147) 159 (169) 181 sts, and work (2) 2 (2) 2 (3) 3 cm ribbing back and forth in this manner:

(First row = WS) 1 edge st, p1, *k1, p1*, rep from *-* end with 1 edge st.

Change to 3 mm circular ndl.

Insert marker around 1 st at each side with (30) 32 (35) 38 (40) 43 sts for each front and (65) 71 (75) 81 (87) 93 sts for the back.

Cont St-st back and forth inside 1 edge st at each side until work meas approx (15) 15 (17) 18 (22) 24 cm.
Cast off 7 sts at each side for armholes (= marked st + 3 sts at each side)

Put aside and work sleeves.

Sleeves:

With 2.5 mm double pointed ndls cast on (34) 36 (38) 40 (42) 44 sts. Join and work (2) 2 (2) 2 (3) 3 cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds.

Change to 3 mm double pointed ndls. Insert marker around first st.

Insert marker around first st.

Cont St-st and when sleeve meas 4 cm inc 1 st at each side of marker.

Rep inc approx. every (2) 1½ (2) 2 (1½) 1½ cm until (42) 48 (50) 56 (62) 68 sts on rnd. Cont until sleeve meas approx (13) 15 (18) 21 (23) 26 cm.

Cast off 7 middle underarm sts (= marked st + 3 sts at each side).

Put aside and work other sleeve in the

Raglan:

same manner.

Transfer sleeve sts to the circular 3 mm garment ndl, placing one sleeve above each armhole cast-off = (183) 205 (219) 243 (265) 289 sts.

P 1 row from WS and p2tog at each junction. Insert marker around each of these sts = (179) 201 (215) 239 (261) 285 sts and 4 markers.

Cont St-st and dec for raglan on RS rows at each of the 4 markers as follows:

Work until 1 st before marker, sl 2 k-wise (as working k2tog), k1, psso = 8 sts dec.

Rep dec on alt rows a total of (9) 11 (13) 14 (16) 18 times = (107) 113 (111) 127 (133) 141 sts.

Cast off for neck (4) 4 (4) 5 (5) 5 sts at each side of row, at the same time cont raglan dec

Leave rem sts on ndl for neck.

Finishing:

Sew tog at underarm.

Left front band girl/ right boy:

With 2.5 mm circular ndl knit up at front edge 1 st every st/row, but miss every 4th st/row to approx. (57) 63 (69) 77 (87) 97 sts.

Number of sts a multiple of 2+1.

Work 2 cm ribbing back and forth in same manner as back/front.

Cast off rib-wise.

Right front band girl/ left boy:

Work in the same manner as other side but with (5) 5 (5) 6 (6) 6 buttonholes evenly spaced after 1 cm. The lower approx 2 cm from cast on row, the upper on neckband. This is done later.

Buttonhole: k/p2tog, 1 yo.

Neckband:

Transfer neck sts to 2.5 mm circular ndl and at the same time knit up sts at neck edge to approx (73) 77 (81) 85 (89) 93 sts.

Number of sts a multiple of 2+1.

Work 2 cm ribbing as for back/front, and remember last buttonhole after approx 1 cm.

Cast off rib-wise. Sew buttons on.

BASIC ROMPER

Solid color romper Instruction: Anita Brathetland

Sizes:

(0-3) 6-9 mos (1) 2 yrs

Measurements:

Chest width: (50) 55 (61) 65 cm Length: approx (32) 36 (38) 43 cm All measurements are for the finished garment = personal body measurements + movement allowance. The measurements are all according to given tension.

Yarn:

BABYULL LANETT (100 % merino wool, 50 g = 175 m)

Alternative yarn:

MINI ALPAKKA, MANDARIN PETIT, TYNN MERINOULL, ALPAKKA SILKE, SISU

Note: If alternative yarn is chosen be sure to check the yardage on label. The image of garment might change by using alternative yarn

Yarn required:

Lt.grey melange #1022: (2) 2 (3) 3 balls

Notions:

4 snaps

2 buttons

Suggested knitting needles:

Circular 2.5 mm and 3 mm

Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle

Tension:

27 sts St-st with 3 mm ndls = 10 cm

Edge st: k every row

Back:

With 3 mm circular ndl cast on (21) 21 (23) 23 sts, and p 1 row from WS. Work (4) 4 (6) 6 cm St-st back and forth inside 1 edge st at each side. Cont St-st, at the same time cast on 3 new sts at end of every row at each side (8) 9 (10) 11 times = (69) 75 (83) 89 sts.

Transfer sts to spare ndl and work front.

Front:

With 3 mm circular ndl cast on (21) 21 (23) 23 sts and k 1 row from WS. Cont St-st, **at the same time** cast on at end of every row at each side 6 sts (0)0(1)1 time, 5 sts twice for all sizes, 4 sts twice for all sizes, 3 sts (2)3(2)3 times = (69) 75 (83) 89 sts.

Back and front:

Transfer sts for both parts to same 3 mm circular ndl = (138) 150 (166) 178 sts. Join and work 1 rnd St-st and at the same time k2tog at each junction and insert marker around this st = (136) 148 (164) 176 sts and 2 markers.

Cont St-st in rnds until work meas approx (20) 22 (24) 27 cm at middle front.

Cast off (9) 9 (11) 11 sts at each side for armholes (= marked st + (4) 4 (5) 5 sts at each side).

Work each part separately.

Back:

= (59) 65 (71) 77 sts.

Cont St-st inside 1 edge st at each side, and cast off for armhole at beg of every row at each side 3 sts (3)4(5)5 times, 2 sts (2)1(1)2 times, and 1 st once for size 6-9-mos only = (33) 35 (37) 39 sts rem.

Cont until back meas approx (6) 7 (7) 8 cm, from dividing for armholes. Leave sts on ndl and work front.

Front:

= (59) 65 (71) 77 sts.

Cont St-st inside 1 edge st at each side and cast off for armholes in the same manner as the back = (33) 35 (37) 39 sts.

Cont until front meas (5) 6 (6) 7 cm from dividing for armholes. Leave sts on ndl.

Finishing:

Armhole bands:

With 2.5 mm circular ndl knit up at armhole edge approx 1 st every st/row, but miss every 4th st/row to approx (49) 57 (65) 73 sts.

Number of sts a multiple of 2+1.

Work 1 cm ribbing back and forth as follows: (First row = WS) 1 edge st, p1, *k1, p1*, rep from *-* end with 1 edge st.

Cast off rib-wise.

Work in the same manner at other armhole.

Buttonhole band at front:

Transfer sts at front to 2.5 mm circular ndl and knit up 4 sts over each armhole band = (41) 43 (45) 47 sts. Work 2 cm ribbing as armhole bands, at the same time work 1 buttonhole at each side after 1 cm as follows: Work 4 sts, k2tog, 1 yo, work until 6 sts rem, 1 yo, k2tog, work 4 sts. Cast off rib-wise.

Band and straps on the back:

Transfer sts at the back to 2.5 mm circular ndl and knit up 4 sts over each armhole band = (41) 43 (45) 47 sts.

Work 2 cm ribbing as armhole bands. Cast off the (23) 25 (27) 29 middle sts, and work each strap separately. Cont ribbing until strap meas approx (9) 10 (11) 12 cm, or suitable length. Work other strap the same.

Leg band:

With 2.5 mm circular ndl knit up at leg edge approx 1 st every st/row, but miss every 4th st/row to approx (59) 63 (67) 71 sts.

Number of sts a multiple of 2+1. Work 2 cm ribbing back and forth in this manner: 1 edge st, p1, *k1, p1*, rep from *-*, end with 1 edge st. Cast off rib-wise.

Work in the same manner at other leg.

Band at crotch for snaps:

With 2.5 mm circular ndl knit up 1 st every st/row on cast-on row and leg band to approx (33) 33 (35) 35 sts.

Number of sts a multiple of 2+1.

Work 2 cm ribbing as leg band.

Cast off rib-wise.

Work in the same manner at front. Sew buttons on straps and sew snaps at crotch.

BASIC KNEE SOCKS

Solid color knee socks Instruction: Anita Brathetland

Sizes:

(0-3) 6 (9) 12 mos (2) 4 yrs

Measurements:

Foot length: (10) 10½ (11) 12 (13) 15 cm

Sock length: (10) 11 (12) 13 (14) 16 cm + heel

All measurements are for the finished garment = personal body measurements + movement allowance. The measurements are all according to given tension.

Yarn:

BABYULL LANETT (100 % merino wool, 50 g = 175 m)

Alternative yarn:

MINI ALPAKKA, MANDARIN PETIT, TYNN MERINOULL, ALPAKKA SILKE, SISU

Note: If alternative yarn is chosen be sure to check the yardage on label. The image of garment might change by using alternative yarn

Yarn required:

Brownish pink #3544: 1 ball all sizes

Suggested knitting needles:

Double pointed 3 mm

Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle

Tension:

27 sts St-st with 3 mm ndls = 10 cm

Edge st: k every row

With 3 mm double pointed ndls cast on (42) 46 (50) 54 (58) 58 sts. Join and work (10) 11 (12) 13 (14) 16 cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds.

Work 1 rnd St-st and dec 12 sts evenly spaced = (30) 34 (38) 42 (46) 46 sts.

Insert marker around the last (15) 17 (19) 21 (23) 23 sts (= instep sts) and work heel over the first (15) 17 (19) 21 (23) 23 sts on rnd in this manner:

Work $(2\frac{1}{2})$ $2\frac{1}{2}$ (3) 3 $(3\frac{1}{2})$ 4 cm St-st back and forth, inside 1 edge st at each side.

Work until (4) 5 (6) 6 (7) 7 sts at side, turn and work St-st until (4) 5 (6) 6 (7) 7 sts at other side.

Turn and work until 1 st before turning, sl 1, k1, psso, turn and work until 1 st before turning at other side, p2tog.

Turn and dec in this manner until all side sts are dec.

Pick up (8) 9 (10) 10 (11) 11 sts at each side of heel.

Insert marker at each side of instep sts.

Cont St-st in rnds over all sts, at the same time dec 1 st at each side of instep sts as follows: k2tog before marker, and k2tog tbl after marker.

Rep dec on alt rnds (3) 5 (5) 5 (5) 5 times = (32) 32 (36) 40 (44) 44 sts on rnd.

Cont St-st in rnds over all sts until foot, including heel meas (8) $8\frac{1}{2}$ (9) 10 (11) 13 cm, or approx 2 cm before suitable length.

Toe dec: Work *k2, k2tog*, rep from ** in the rnd = (24) 24 (27) 30 (33) 33
sts.

Work 2 rnds with no dec.

Work *k1, k2tog*, rep from *-* in the rnd = (16) 16 (18) 20 (22) 22 sts

Work 2 rnds with no dec.

Work k2tog in the rnd = (8) 8 (9) 10 (11) 11 sts.

Cut yarn, pass through sts, gather and fasten well.

Work other sock in the same manner, but insert marker around the first (15) 17 (19) 21 (23) 23 sts (= instep sts) and work heel over the last (15) 17 (19) 21 (23) 23 sts.

BASIC BONNET

Solid color bonnet Instruction: Anita Brathetland

Sizes:

(0-3) 6-9 mos (1) 2 yrs

Yarn:

BABYULL LANETT (100 % merino wool, 50 g = 175 m)

Alternative yarn:

MINI ALPAKKA, MANDARIN PETIT, TYNN MERINOULL, ALPAKKA SILKE, SISU

Note: If alternative yarn is chosen be sure to check the yardage on label. The image of garment might change by using alternative yarn

Yarn required:

Dk.terracotta #4035: 1 ball all sizes

Suggested knitting needles:

Circular and double pointed 3 mm Circular 2.5 mm

Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle

Tension

27 sts St-st with 3 mm ndls = 10 cm

Edge st: k every row

Begin at face line.

With 2.5 mm circular ndl cast on (73) 81 (89) 97 sts and work 2 cm ribbing back and forth in this manner: (First row = WS) 1 edge st, p1, *k1, p1*, rep from *-* end with 1 edge st.

Change to 3 mm circular ndl.

Work 1 row St-st and inc 8 sts evenly spaced = (81) 89 (97) 105 sts.

Cont St-st back and forth, inside 1 edge st at each side until work meas (12) 13 (14) 15 cm.

Change to double pointed 3 mm ndls, join work and k first and last st tog on first rnd = (80) 88 (96) 104 sts.

Cont St-st, work 1 rnd and dec on next rnd as follows: *k2, k2tog*, rep from *-* in the rnd = (60) 66 (72) 78 sts

Work 3 rnds with no dec.

Next rnd: *k1, k2tog*, rep from *-* in the rnd = (40) 44 (48) 52 sts.

Work 3 rnds with no dec.

Next rnd: k2tog in the rnd = (20) 22 (24) 26 sts.

Work 1 rnd with no dec. Next rnd: k2tog in the rnd = (10) 11 (12) 13 sts. Cut yarn, pass through sts, gather and fasten well.

Neckband:

With 2.5 mm circular ndl knit up approx (65) 73 (81) 89 sts at neck edge, and work 4 cm ribbing back and forth as at beg of bonnet. Cast off ribwise

Fold band to WS and sew loosely with hidden sts.

Cord:

With 3 mm double pointed ndl cast on 4 sts and work in this manner: k 1 row, slide sts back to other end of ndl, hold yarn firmly and k sts. Rep this and always k sts from same side without turning

Cont until cord meas approx (64) 66 (68) 70 cm.

Cast off

Pass cord through neckband.





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
